Ephesians 5:15, 16 (AMP)

¹⁵Look carefully then how you walk! Live purposefully and worthily and accurately, not as the unwise and witless, but as wise (sensible, intelligent people), ¹⁶Making the very most of the time [buying up each opportunity], because the days are evil.

The Chinese word for “**crisis**” is actually made up of two other words joined together. One means “danger”, the other means “opportunity.”

The only way to seize the day is to be present in the **present**.

Let me ask you a question – do the dimensions of your living equal the dimensions of His **purpose** for your life?

His purpose for you is pregnant with divine possibility but integrated with **human** responsibility.

Psalms 90:12 – So teach us to number our days that we may get us a heart of wisdom.

The words “number our days” mean “to **weigh**” or “to **measure**.”

The word translated purposefully, accurately means to be cautious, sensitive, aware, **alert**.

“**Acrobat**” means “one who is skilled in feats of balance and agility in gymnastics; or one who changes one’s viewpoint on short notice in response to the circumstances.

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Second, we must walk (live) in **wisdom**.

Proverbs 9:10(a) – The fear of the Lord is the beginning of wisdom...

A **wise** person is one who fears God, who is broken before God, and has a reverential awe for the holiness and majesty of God.

Proverbs 9:10(b) – ...The knowledge of the Holy One is insight and understanding.

Colossians 1:9 - For this reason we also, from the day we heard of it, have not ceased to pray and make [special] request for you, [asking] that you may be filled with the [full (deep and clear) knowledge of His will in all spiritual wisdom [in comprehensive insight into the ways and purposes of God] and in understanding and discernment of spiritual thing...

“Filled” in Colossians 1:9 means **controlled**.

Third, we are to redeem the time or make the most of every **opportunity**.

You purchase your moments by the **choices** you make.

Our **destiny** is determined by our use of our kairos moments.

The most important principle for human growth and development is how you respond to your **seasons**.

Next Steps:

1. I will seize the day in every season of my life.
2. I will live purposefully and accurately His will for my life.
3. I will make the most of every opportunity regardless of my season.
